

CT IMAGING

Discover how to structure and set up a relationship between hospital and EMS teams and enrol your team in Advanced Stroke Life Support (ASLS), the premier eLearning course for stroke education for emergency medical teams.

HYPERACUTE

Streamline and standardise your stroke protocols using a quick interactive tool based on four key priority actions in the hyperacute phase, and refresh your knowledge of the NIHSS clinical assessment tool to evaluate stroke severity.

POST ACUTE

Stroke nurse certification is earned by completing all 20 modules in Stroke Basics for Nurses. Additional tranining focuses on how dysphagia screening reduces mortality in stroke and how the discharge checklist standardises post-stroke evaluation and ensures that patient discharge proceeds within guideline recommendations.

Learning resources: The training journey is supported and enriched by a comprehensive menu of learning resources that include panel discussions, expert presentations, training videos and checklists.

Speaker resources: For those responsible for educating others about stroke, the Angels Academy provides a comprehensive list of slides, videos and other media to maximise the impact of your training.

THE ESO & WSO ANGELS AWARDS ARE DESIGNED TO

ACKNOWLEDGE & HONOUR

TEAMS AND INDIVIDUALS COMMITTED TO QUALITY IMPROVEMENT IN STROKE PRACTICE. AND TO ESTABLISH A CULTURE OF CONTINUED MONITORING.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Hospitals become eligible for an ESO or WSO Angels Award if they capture treatment data in RES-Q, SITS-QR or in one of the pre-approved registries/databases and submit a quarterly report summarising their performance. Hospitals are evaluated based on criteria that align with ESO and WSO quality measures.

Based on your performance in these different measures, your hospital may be awarded Gold. Platinum or Diamond Status.
