

PREHOSPITAL

☐	Patient info (age, name, social security number)
☐	Last seen normal
☐	Stroke scale performed
☐	Patient medication
☐	Blood glucose measured
☐	Blood pressure measured
☐	Prenotification

HYPERACUTE / DECISION MAKING

☐	Prenotification (Laboratory, CT scanner, Stroke unit)
☐	Patient brought directly to CT
☐	Shortened NIHSS performed
☐	Diagnosis of stroke
☐	Clear communication with patient
☐	Clear communication and parallel work within the Stroke team
☐	Nurse: Monitoring of patient
☐	POC testing done
☐	Nurse: insert IV lines
☐	Nurse: take bloods
☐	Nurse: check patient weight
☐	Contraindications checked (pre-mRS, medication, anticoagulants etc.)
☐	Check blood pressure again
☐	Patient treated at CT

CT IMAGING

☐	Decide on type of CT method (plain CT, CTA, CTP)
☐	Set the correct windowing
☐	Scrolling to look for bleeding and mimics (e.g. tumors and abscesses)
☐	Scrolling to basal ganglia and evaluate ASPECTS regions
☐	Determine potential treatment options based on imaging checklists
