APPLICATION PROCESS

Hospitals who capture data in either the RES-Q Registry, SITS Registry using the ESO Awards Protocol or an approved National Registry are eligible for an award. Awards are based on the ESO quality measures.

ESO QUALITY MEASURES

- 1 % of patients treated with door to recanalization therapy time < 60 minutes
- 2 % recanalisation procedure rate out of total ischaemic stroke incidence in the hospital
- 3 % of all suspected stroke patients undergoing CT or MRI imaging procedure
- 4 % of all stroke patients undergoing dysphagia screen
- 5 % of ischaemic stroke patients discharged with antiplatelets
- 6 % of atrial fibrillation related stroke patients discharged with anticoagulants
- 7 Stroke patients treated in a dedicated stroke unit or ICU during their hospital stay

THE REWARDS

Every quarter, based on the data from the past 3 months, participating hospitals will be awarded either Gold, Platinum or Diamond Status.

All hospitals that qualify for a specific award will receive materials to promote their status to the public community.

Current Diamond centers will be recognised every year at the ESOC conference attended by leading experts in the field.



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
